**Position: Research Field Supervisor**

Centre for Mental Health and Counselling-Nepal is conducting a research study on acceptability, appropriateness, adoption, feasibility, fidelity, cost, penetration and sustainability of Community Mental Health and Psychosocial Counselling Services for conflict victims of Nepal. Research follows both quantitative and qualitative methods to collect data from the project area of Psychosocial Counselling for Community Integration of Conflict Victims (PCCICV) in five districts (Kavre, Bardiya, Surkhet, Jajarkot and Rukum West).
